
From the Pastor.

What Is Our Purpose?

Purpose has become quite vogue in the church of the twenty-first century. This is a good thing. Rick Warren from the great Saddleback Church in southern California has impacted the body of Christ in a powerful way with his book *The Purpose Driven Life*. I truly believe that this book is a word from the Lord for the church of Christ in these days. For too long too many wandered aimlessly through life with no real sense of purpose.

This "purpose driven" emphasis has greatly energized those who have embraced it. The purpose of GT Church can be summed up in two words. Those words are communion and community. This is God's purpose for the church. Communion has to do with connecting with God and community is connecting with each other. This principle was illustrated beautifully by Christ in Luke 10:27. When asked about the most important commandment, Jesus responded with a two-fold answer. "Love the Lord with all that is within you and love your neighbor as yourself."

In many respects all the law is summed up in these two expectations. Life is certainly more complex than just this one concept, but when it comes to the church we can focus on these words of Christ as our purpose. What are we to be doing? We are to be connecting people with God and with each other. The work of the church is connecting, connecting with God (communion) and connecting with each other (community).

They have served as missionaries with Assembly of God World Missions for ten years. They are presently serving in Belgium as Campus Pastor at Continental Theological Seminary and assisting the Fellowship of European International Churches. The past 48 years of ministry include leading youth and young adults as a youth pastor/DYD and encouraging pastors and missionaries.

The Tom and Phyllis minister throughout Europe for the Fellowship of International Churches, with an emphasis on the Holy Spirit. They partner with the Pentecostal European Fellowship, in citywide evangelism outreaches across Europe and in church planting efforts.

Tom Benigas declares: "The complexion of Europe's people is constantly changing and today it is more colorful than ever! We realize this on a daily basis in our ministry environments as we share the message of Jesus across Europe in international churches. Whether in Sweden, Austria, France or Montenegro, we are privileged to minister on any given Sunday to hungry souls that come from at least 10 and up to 30 different people groups. At Continental Theological Seminary (CTS), our students this past year came from 35 countries and what a joy, and challenge sometimes, it is to pastor them."

GT Church Missions Trip Kenya, Africa April 25 - May 6, 2022



GT Church is sending a missions team to Kenya in east Africa on April 25 for ten days of pastor training, 3 days of street ministry in Nairobi, and working with Connect With a Child Ministry.

Connect With a Child is a holistic care program that was initiated as a response to the overwhelming number of poor orphans and vulnerable women in Kenya, whose lives have been ravaged by death, disease and poverty. Connect With a Child has been a major force in missions for over 10 years. The ministry has given opportunities for over 1,000 children who are headed towards primary and high school graduation, vocational training and university graduation. Connect With a Child has drilled wells to provide water so that over 60,000 people are abe to access clean drinking water. The ministry runs an orphanage and is building a school to provide education to the children.








Adult Bible Study


Greetings in Jesus' Name!

In view of the motion taken by your assembly at the meeting held September 25, 1932, copy of the minutes having been received by this office, we hereby officially recognize the Glad Tidings Tabernacle at St. Petersburg, Florida as one of the local assemblies of God.

It is to be understood that this action on the part of the Assembly, with this accompanying official recognition, gives to the local assembly the right of representation in all General Council meetings, and it is urged that the assembly send their pastor and one delegate to such General Council meetings to represent the local assembly.
